## SUPPORT

### **HB 1377**

Creates the Oklahoma (SAFE) Act; which outlaws gender-confirming care for minors.

### **HB 1011**

Outlaws gender-confirming care for any individual under 21.

### **SB 408**

Creating the Women's Bill of Rights; Women are defined as individuals declared female at birth.

### **HB 2186**

Ban engaging, organizing or authorizing an "adult cabaret performance," which includes drag.

## THE FACTS

### DID YOU KNOW?

According to the NIH, adolescence is an important time for brain development.

The brain finishes developing and maturing in the mid-to-late 20s. The part of the brain behind the forehead, called the prefrontal cortex, is one of the last parts to mature. This area is responsible for skills like planning, prioritizing, and making good decisions.

According to the CDC, child sexual abuse refers to the involvement of a child (person less than 18 years old) in sexual activity that violates the laws or social taboos of society and that he/she:

- does not fully comprehend
- does not consent to or is unable to give informed consent to, or
- is not developmentally prepared for and cannot give consent to

According to the CDC, the parents are responsible for ensuring that children have safe, stable, nurturing relationships and environments.
