SB 222/ HB 305 - **DIED IN SENATE & HOUSE**

Make "vaccination or immunity status" a protected class in our civil rights statute, prohibiting discrimination.

HB 1069 - **APPROVED BY GOVERNOR**

Defines biological sex when teaching sex education in schools with materials approved by the Department of Education.

HB 1013

Prohibits business entities, government & schools from imposing COVID-19 testing, facial covering, & vaccination mandates.

According to the NIH, Informed Consent

is the process in which a health care provider educates a patient about the risks, benefits, and alternatives of a given procedure or intervention. Informed consent is both an ethical and legal obligation of medical practitioners in the US and originates from the patient's right to direct what happens to their body.

Children and Informed Consent

According to the NIH, Children (typically under 17) cannot provide informed consent. As such, parents must permit treatments or interventions. In this case, it not termed "informed consent" but "informed permission."
